The average rates for teenagers on their own policies range from \$7,625 per year for full coverage for a 16-year-old to \$4,132 a year for a full-coverage policy for a 19-year-old. However, drivers can save money by adding a teen to a parent's policy rather than the teen purchasing one on their own. Furthermore, car insurance is cheaper for female teens than for male teens to the tune of hundreds of dollars per year.
